





Receiver Panel




- ① Power input jack
- ② Status of power input: indicates that power is available to the unit
- ③ Status of link: when ON indicates that an HDBaseT™ link connection has been established between the two boards over the CAT5e/6 cable
- **4** IR-TX Port
- (5) IR-RX Port
- 6 HDMI input port
- 7 RJ45 connector
- ® Power connector : input DC5V 2A

Connecting and Operating

- ① Connect the HDMI signal source to HDMI transmitter(TX).
- ② Connect CAT5e/6 cable to both the CAT5e/6 port of Transmitter and CAT5e/6 port of Receiver, The RJ45 connections must follow EIA-TIA 568B standards.
- ③ Connect the HDMI output from the Receiver(RX) into the display HDMI input.
- 4 Connect the power supply into power input jack.
- (5) Connect IR-TX cable into IR-TX port on the Transmitter and affix the emitter onto the source IR windows.
- ⑥ Connect IR-RX cable into IR-RX port on the Receiver and affix the IR Receiver in direct line of site with the handheld remote control, it is recommended to affix the Receiver on the display frame/bezel or the display stand.
- (7) Gently insert/Extract all cable.

MAINTENANCE

Clean this unit with a soft, dry cloth. Never use alcohol, paint thinner of benzene to clean this unit.

PRODUCT SERVICE

Damage requiring service:

- (b) Objects or liquids have gotten into the unit
- (c) The unit has been exposed to rain
- (d) The unit does not operate normally or exhibits a marked change in performance
- (e) The unit has been dropped or the cabinet damaged

Servicing Personnel: Do not attempt to service the unit beyond that described in these operating instructions. Refer all other servicing to authorized servicing personnel.

Replacement parts: When parts need replacing ensure the servicer uses parts specified by the manufacturer or parts that have the same characteristics as the original parts. Unauthorized substitutes may result in fire, electric shock, or other hazards.

Safety check: After repairs or service, ask the servicer to perform safety checks to confirm that the unit is in proper working condition.

WARRANTY

If your product does work properly because of a defect materials or workmanship, our company (referred to as "the warrantor") will, for the length of the period indicated as below, (Parts2) Year, Labor (90) Days which start with the date of original purchase ("Limited Warranty period"), at its option either (a) repair your products with new or refurbished parts, or (b) replace it with a new of a refurbished product, The decision to repair or replace will be by the warrantor, During the "Labor" Limited Warranty period there will be no charge for labor.

During the "Parts" warranty period, there will be charge for parts. You mist mail-in your product during the warranty period. This Limited Warranty is extended only to the original purchaser and only covers product purchased as new. A purchase receipt or other proof of original purchase date is required for Limited Warranty service.
